- What kind of classes do I want to take/fulfill abroad?
 - GE's?
 - Major classes?
 - Minor classes?
 - Language?
 - Research?
- What classes do I need to take before I study abroad?
- Which classes for my major *must* be taken at UCI?
 - i.e. equivalents can't be taken abroad
- Is there any course sequence in my major I can't miss?
- What class level must I be to participate on my preferred program?
- What language level must I have to participate on my preferred program?
- What is the best time for me to study abroad...
 - Financially?
 - Academically?
 - Personally (club, internship, or research involvement, etc.)?
- What are the dates of my program? How many qtrs will I be away from UCI?
