- ◆ Meet the minimum GPA requirement for your study abroad program.
- ◆ Submit your completed scholarship application by the specified deadline below.

UCI Friends of Study Abroad Scholarship: Up to 6 awards annually of \$800 - \$1200	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be participating in a UCEAP, IOP study, or UC Davis Quarter abroad program. • Must be participating on a program during the academic year. <i>Summer-only applicants will NOT be considered.</i> • Must take at least one course while abroad which will fulfill a UCI degree requirement (major, minor or GE) • Must be receiving financial aid. • Must be returning to UCI for at least 1 quarter following study abroad participation. • Must plan to engage in some activity beyond the classroom while abroad, e.g. volunteering, internship, research, etc. Preference given to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full-year participants • Students with a strong academic record • Students returning to UCI for at least one year following study abroad participation. 	March 4, 2019: Programs beginning in summer or fall. October 22, 2018: Programs beginning in winter or spring
UCI Black Lives Matter Abroad Scholarship: <i>Funding TBD</i>	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be interested in conducting research on the ways that Black social, cultural and economic movements operate, educate, and advocate around the world. • Must participate in a program abroad to be awarded the scholarship. • Must submit an essay addressing one of the scholarship questions. 	March 22, 2019 <i>(On hold, funding TBD)</i>
UCI Humanities Scholarship: Two awards of \$1,000	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be participating in a UCEAP study abroad program. • Must be participating on a program during the academic year. Summer-only applicants will NOT be considered. • Must be a major in UCI's School of Humanities, <i>at the time of application</i> for the scholarship. • Must have a strong academic record. • Supplemental items Preference given to:	March 22, 2019

UCI School of Engineering Travel Scholarship: 2-4 awards of \$500 - \$1000	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be participating in a UCEAP program only. • Must be a major in UCI's Henry Samueli School of Engineering <i>at the time of application</i> for this scholarship. • Must take at least one engineering class while abroad. • Must have a strong academic record. Preference given to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with financial need. • Students returning to UCI for at least 1 quarter following study abroad participation. 	March 22, 2019
Raad Hermes Memorial Scholarship \$2,000 awards	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be participating in a UCEAP or IOP study abroad program. • Must be participating on a program during the academic year. Summer-only applicants will NOT be considered. • Minimal competency in Iraqi Arabic • Supplemental essay question: In not more than one page, please describe your level of familiarity with Iraqi Arabic and how you developed it. Also include any experience you have in Iraq or with Iraqi culture. Preference given to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with financial need. • Students who will take at least one course while abroad which will fulfill a UCI degree requirement (major, minor or GE). • Students returning to UCI for at least 1 quarter following study abroad participation. 	March 22, 2019: Programs beginning in summer or fall. October 22, 2018: Programs beginning in winter or spring
UCI-Semester at Sea Scholarship Fall: 4 at \$3,125 Spring: 4 at \$3,125	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be participating in a Semester at Sea program only. Preference given to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students with financial need. • Students who will take at least one course while abroad which will fulfill a UCI degree requirement (major, minor or GE). • Students returning to UCI for at least 1 quarter following study abroad participation.
