Established in 1935 in Tainan, Taiwan, NCKU is a research-led university that was a major participant in the first Taiwan Economic Miracle.

NCKU is academically active in all areas critical to Taiwan's quality of life and sustainability, including 11 colleges, from energy to health and from AI to the arts.

It has 11 campuses, an undergraduate population of more than 10k students, of which 9.5% are international students.

ACADEMICS AND REGISTRATION

There are two semesters in one academic year:

Fall Semester = mid-September~mid January Spring Semester = mid-February~late June

How and When to Apply?

- 2 Steps Process:
 - 1. Request UCI campus approval in UCIAbroad portal
 - Open Date = November 1st
 - Deadlines
 - Fall Term = February 15
 - Spring Term = August 15
 - 2. <u>Submit online application in NCKU</u>
 - Fall Semester = April 10
 - Spring Semester* = October 15

*Spring Semester in NCKU includes both winter and spring quarters at UCI



Students interested in applying for this program must be 1st nominated by the UCI Study Abroad Center.

Please note that academic year 112 means AY2023 and semester 1 means the fall semester and semester 2 the spring semester.

Courses are mainly taught in Chinese. But options in English can be found in NCKU Course Information and Course System.

COURSE INFO & COURSE RESTRICTIONS

Students are allowed to take courses offered by other departments/institutes, as well as courses of different program years and levels.

Graduate courses are allowed for exchange students as long as the providing professors set no restrictions.

Traveling to MILIANUS VISA REQUIREMENTS

Exchange students must apply for a Taiwan (ROC) visitor visa with annotation "FS" followed by the name of the host university, prior to entering Taiwan.



HOW TO APPLY?

Visit UCIAbroad portal

Click→ "UCI abroad login" → "UC IrvineStudents"

Click→ "HERE to Log In" → log in using your UCInetID credentials.



If this is your first time logging into UCIAbroad, you will be prompted to complete your profile first.

Click "Apply Here" and search for the program using keywords or filters →
Sample keywords/filters: UCI-Bilateral Exchange Program [name of host institution]

Click "Apply for" on the program, → Complete the "Pre-Acceptance" portion in UCI Abroad Portal.

Hit → "Submit application"

Once the Study Abroad Center received your application, it will be reviewed by the nomination committee. You will receive an email indicating the status of your application (Nominated by Campus or Not Nominated by Campus), as well as the steps to follow.

If your application is moved to "Nominated by Campus", you'll be prompted to submit the application to the host university, as well as complete the "Post-Acceptance" portion in UCI Abroad Portal.
