# Applying to 211

### ACADEMICS AND REGISTRATION


The academic year runs from March to December and is made up of 2 terms at KU.

- Spring Term (semester 1) = March June
- Fall Term (semester 2) = September December

How and When to Apply?

2 Steps Process:

- 1. Request UCI campus approval in UCIAbroad portal
  - Open Date = November 1st
  - Deadlines
    - Fall Term = February 15
    - Spring Term = August 15
- 2. Submit online application in KU
  - Fall Term = April 1 April 31
  - Spring Term\*= TBD



Students interested in applying for this program must be 1st nominated by the UCI Study Abroad Center.

- Click here for course list → click on English on the right side of the main page.
  - Courses taught in English will be shown in brackets (e.g. Marketing Management (English))
  - For the latest course list, students are required to check it in January for spring semester and in July for fall semester
- Exchange students can take max 19 credits per semester, and aren't allowed to take graduate courses.
- Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Law, Teacher Education, School of Cybersecurity (Department of Cyber defense), Art & Design, and all courses at Sejong Campus are not open to exchange students.

# Traveling to 411 VISA REQUIREMENTS

- Students are required to obtain a D-2 visa (exchange student visa) prior to their arrival in Korea.
- After arrival, students must not leave the country before an Alien Registration Card is issued. Otherwise, the D-2 visa will automatically expire, and students must process a new student visa at the Korean embassy in their country.



UCI tuition and fees	\$5,735.25
Airfare (round-trip, changeable)	\$1,400.00
On-campus housing	\$2,278.00
Meals	\$1,820.34
Books and Supplies	\$303.45
Transportation	\$303.45

TOTAL = \$11,840.49



### HOW TO APPLY?

#### Visit UCIAbroad portal

Click→ "UCI abroad login" → "UC IrvineStudents"

Click→ "HERE to Log In" → log in using your UCInetID credentials.



If this is your first time logging into UCIAbroad, you will be prompted to complete your profile first.

Click "Apply Here" and search for the program using keywords or filters →
Sample keywords/filters: UCI-Bilateral Exchange Program [name of host institution]

Click "Apply for" on the program, → Complete the "Pre-Acceptance" portion in UCI Abroad Portal.

Hit → "Submit application"

Once the Study Abroad Center received your application, it will be reviewed by the nomination committee. You will receive an email indicating the status of your application (Nominated by Campus or Not Nominated by Campus), as well as the steps to follow.

If your application is moved to "Nominated by Campus", you'll be prompted to submit the application to the host university, as well as complete the "Post-Acceptance" portion in UCIAbroad portal.
